Most of you know that the "on-campus training for our Year 2 students" commenced on Monday, 15 Jun 2020 due to Covid-19. Then, we started takeaways as dine-in was not allowed, Chef Trainer, Ms Wong planned affordable 4-choices bento menu weekly and Ernest created all the menus in colourful prints. During term 4, Phase 2 opening eased and dine-in are allowed, I am happy that our students served a total of 16 sessions, with a total of 349 pax eating at the cafe and 436 takeaways. We were able to achieve this because of your kind and continued support. MVS Cafe completed this year's service on Thursday, 12 November 2020 with a lot of dine-ins (34 pax). This overbooking situation had allowed our students to experience table turnovers as our cafe's full capacity was limited to 20 people only. On behalf of Ms Wong, our students and I, we are very thankful for the opportunity to serve you all. Most of my students enjoyed serving all of you and many of them become bolder in their communication and they remembered your name. I am proud to announce that the students will be officially complete their training on 20 November 2020 and will enter into the real working world. We wish them all the best! ## YEAR-END CELEBRATION

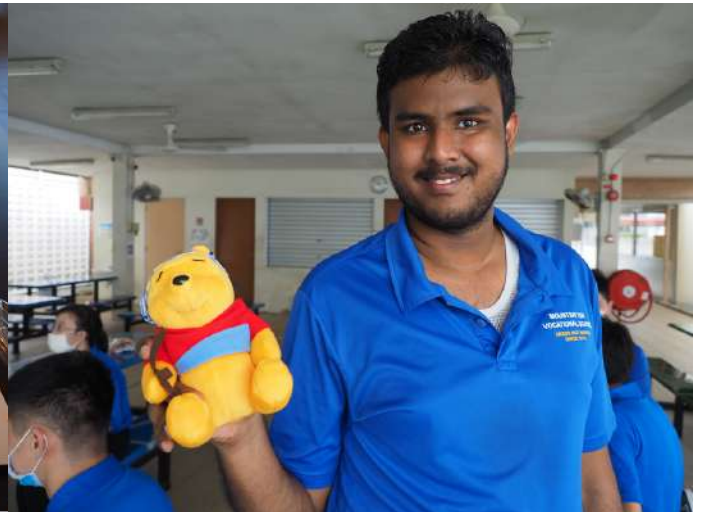
